Project overarching objective

In Africa, national VET systems are not delivering the skills required by the waste management sector. This problem increases because of limited opportunities for upskilling and reskilling, making it even more difficult to meet the sector's evolving skill demands.

CircuwasteVETAfrica is an Erasmus+ project that promotes VET in Green Waste Management and Circular Economy to increase sustainable employment for youth and women.





The project will promote circular waste management jobs like: **environmental inspectors, recycle, upcycle specialists and collecting/sorting workers** in manufacturing companies, waste management companies, waste collectors and recycling companies.

VET Training programmes

Two separate programmes will be implemented: a Training of Trainers (ToT) programme for 20 trainers in Ghana, Angola, and São Tomé, followed by the training of 150 students among all the countries in essential skills and knowledge related to circular waste management and the circular economy.



Train the Trainer programme

This programme structured into six specialised modules that empower trainers with pedagogical expertise and technical proficiency.
